**REFLECTIONS FROM
FATHER CHARLES SHEEHY**

One definition of surprise might be "wonder". All of a sudden someone or something offers us someone or something that changes a whole picture. It happened in a truly wonderful church south of Boston.

The married couple differed in some instances as all people do. They were devoted to each other and to their children. One difference was religion. She was a Catholic; he was not. Yet he came to Mass each Sunday. He helped in the parish in many ways.

When the wife and children went to Holy Communion, he would stand behind them at a short distance. On one Sunday he stood behind her but surprised her, he went to Holy Communion. His wife was astonished to hear him say, "I've become a Catholic."

The wonderful surprise had developed quietly with the aid of a young priest. His wife had never urged him. Her example led to his conversion.

Whether for adults or children example has a strong influence even if not active. It may come on the scene when we least expect it.

It is the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ that urges us on, especially in trying times.

What will the process of implementation look like?

Now that the *recognition* has been granted, final preparation and publication of the *Missal* will commence. Catechesis on the new translation and on the Liturgy itself will become even more important. Training for priests, music ministers, and other liturgical leaders (liturgy committees and liturgical commissions), as well as formation for all Catholics, will help to ensure the successful implementation of the new text.
